Council wishes to remind all drivers that in accordance with the **Traffic Safety Act of Alberta**, unless otherwise posted that **50km/hr is the maximum speed limit for roads located within an urban area. Playground and school zones are 30 km/hr.** Concerns have been brought to council about the number of vehicles travelling at high rates of speed within the village. For **SAFETY** of our pedestrians, especially the children, please abide by the speed limits and slow down.

Summer is here, to keep our streets visibility and accident free, a reminder to all residents that **By-Law 755-15 FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING AND CONTROLLING MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LOUGHEED** states:

Sec. 9.5 No person shall park any manner of trailer on a street, lane or alley unless the trailer is attached to a vehicle by which it may be properly drawn, and when so attached the trailer shall be part of the vehicle and subject to any regulations pertaining to the vehicle.

and

No person shall place or leave an extension cord across any sidewalk or boulevard for the purpose of operating a vehicle block heater, or for any other purpose. (such as plugging in a trailer)
